English

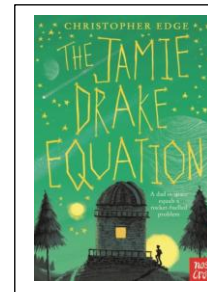
Mini topic: Poetry inspired by the animals of North America. We look at the poem 'Recipe to make a wolf' by Pie Corbett and then use this to inspire our own poems about a bald Eagle.

Jamie Drake Equation: We use this text to influence us with writing diaries.

8 Billion Ideas: We will be writing persuasive texts and jingles to promote our innovations.

RSHE: All about Feelings

We will be learning about our emotions and how they effect us - including coping with changing moods.



French

The children will continue their learning of the French language with Madame Kent. They will be focusing on: Reading the time; places in town and numbers from 1-39.

Science

Earth and Space: We will learn about the planets of our solar system and identifying features. We will also look at Geo and Heliocentric systems, including the ideas of Ptolemy and Copernicus. We will look at time Zones, day and night, seasons and moon phases.

Music

Melody and harmony in music: We will be exploring these two elements of music. We will also be playing, improving and composing music.

History: The Mayans:

We will learn about the ancient civilisation of the Mayans – including looking at where they fit chronologically, their beliefs, number and writing systems and food.

Geography

Mini Topic: We look at the 23 countries and cultures of North America, as well as human and physical features. We then use thematic maps and learn about longitude and latitude and time zones.

Computing

This half term we will be learning about computer systems and networks. We will look at how information is transferred between systems and devices and how we can use the internet to conduct safe searches for information – concentrating on internet safety.

Art

We will be exploring the artwork of Chris Riddell and Adonna Khare looking at their use of lines, shapes, shading, hatching and other pencil techniques. We will then use these techniques to create our own art work of an Eagle (linked to our work on North America).

Design and Technology

8 Billion Ideas: We work together in teams to create world changing ideas. We design and build prototypes of these which are then judged. The winning entry is entered into a national final!
