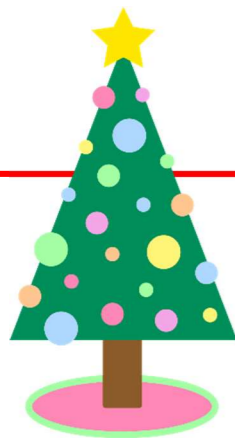


PRIME AREA - Personal, Social and Emotional development
