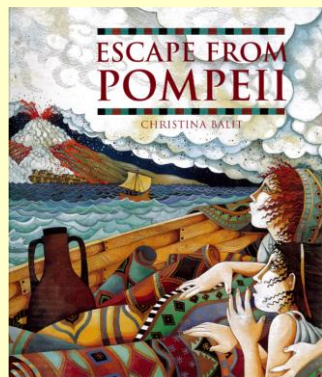


Mathematics
