



Year 1 Maths Fluency Objectives

YEAR 1 MATHS TARGETS FOR PARENTS

As we are focusing on developing fluency in mental calculations, below are the relevant targets for your child's year group. These are to be achieved by the end of the year.

There are of course a whole range of other maths objectives that the children will also be learning about across the year, including those concerning other areas of number and place value, calculations, fractions, measurement, geometry and statistics.

We are aiming for a recall of facts within 3 seconds and without using fingers. This is the current national expectation for what children should be able to do.

MATHS TARGETS – YEAR 1

FLUENCY OBJECTIVES

Count to 100, forwards and backwards starting 0 or 1, or from any given number.

Add and subtract numbers to 20 mentally. (Not timed)

Recall addition and subtraction facts up to 5.

Recall addition doubles up to $5 + 5$

Say the number that is 10 more than any given number to 20.

Represent and use number bonds to 10 and 20 (and related subtraction facts).
